ALL ON LAND

Reports From Far East. Big Battle Looked For Within a Week.

Special to Journal. Seoul, Feb. 26.—Details of a land battle between Cossacks and Japanese near Anju say that a hundred Russians were killed and wounded.

Berlin, Feb. 26.—Germany looks to the United States to take the lead in any protest that may be made against Russia's action in declaring Newchwang under martial law, and in hauling down the American and other flags.

St. Petersburg, Feb. 26.—The War Office expects the first land engagement will take place in about a week. General Kurpil, commanding the first Japanese army in Ping Yang region, has a total strength of 70,000 men, including a brigade of cavalry and 190 cannons. 80,000 Russians are marching towards Ping Yang. Outpost of both armies are already reported to have engaged in skirmishes with no serious results.

CONSPIRACY BILLS

Found Against Finch and McBee by Solicitor Jones.

McBee's Deeds of His A. & N. C. Administration. Governor Aycock and Attorney General Gilmer Summoned as Witnesses. Rumors of Including Others in Conspiracy.

Special to Journal. Raleigh, March 26.—V E McBee who arrived here today, in order to be ready for whatever should turn up in the Superior court, in the case against him for conspiracy, stated that K S Finch would also be on hand, but would arrive later. It is not known whether McBee and Finch will go upon the witness stand.

Speaking of his brief control of the Atlantic and North Carolina Railway, McBee says the largest receipts in any previous March were \$28,544, while during the 17 days in March of his administration, he paid \$16,500 of debts and then gave a check for the balance of \$12,044.

This afternoon the solicitor of this district sent to the grand jury of the Superior court here, a bill against K S Finch of New York, and V E McBee of Portsmouth for conspiracy against the State. The grand jury at once summoned several witnesses, the first being Governor Aycock, others being Attorney General Gilmer, attorneys Hinesdale and Day of the counsel for Finch and McBee. The investigation will be completed tomorrow. Rumors are current that the grand jury may include attorney Hinesdale and Day in its bill. But nothing can be definitely learned.
