NEW QUARTERS SECURED.

The New Bern Military Academy and Carolina Business College Will Locate on Old Fair Grounds.

Saturday Cool J. S. Holladay leased for a term of ten years, the old fair grounds with all buildings. This step will be to the immense advantage of the institution as now they have a chance to expand and increase their membership in a manner that few other locations could afford.

In preparing for the reception of the students about June 1, the buildings which are standing on the fair ground will be thoroughly overhauled and remodeled. The exteriors will be painted and calcimine.

In addition to this there will be erected several new buildings for the ever increasing student attendance which will contain barracks, dormitories, recitation rooms and accommodations for the business college and music department. In all these buildings modern improvements and conveniences will be established and the students will not want for any good thing.

The grounds will be enclosed with a handsome picket fence with an attractive arched entrance. They will be fitted and beautified with the idea of making them the most thoroughly attractive and beautiful grounds in this section of the State. They will also be admirably adapted for drilling the cadets. A fountain will be placed on the campus for the comfort and refreshment of the students.

Twenty-five men will be put to work at once at the construction of these buildings and everything will be pushed as rapidly as possible compatible with safe construction. Several thousand dollars will be expended to make the improvements that have been planned and when they are completed there will be a transformation which will certainly be a great benefit to the city.

The citizens of New Bern should realize that this academy is really a splendid feature in the growth and development of the place. It is in the hands of able, competent young men who are making a success of their venture. Other towns have furnished institutions of similar nature with grounds, buildings and other requisites and it is to the city's interest to make a liberal donation to this school. Several hundred dollars have been promised for the proper equipment of this school and it is hoped that the public spirited people who want to see New Bern grow and flourish will look into this matter and materially assist the young men in this worthy undertaking.

NO DECISION FILED

In Finch-McBoe Case. Preparing For Examination of A. & N. C. Road.

The board of internal improvements of the A. & N. C. road, and the special committee of examiners of the A. and N. C. railway, met this afternoon in the Governor's office and mapped out the work to be done, and the methods of doing it. The examination will be thorough.

Washington, D. C. April 4.—The United States Supreme court handed down a decision on the case of the People's Gas Company vs the City of Chicago. The case was appealed from the United States Circuit court for the northern district of Illinois and the decision was rendered against the gas company.

North Carolina in Sundry Civil Bill.

Duplin Journal.
"The House Committee on Appropriations today completed the sundry civil bill. While the measure indicates a big cut in regular and supplemental estimates, the items affecting North Carolina show up about as expected. Post-office, Durham, limit of cost, \$100,000; already appropriated, \$83,500; completion of building under present limit, \$30,000; Postoffice, Goldsboro, limit of cost, \$50,000; already appropriated, \$38,750; present bill carries for completion of building under present limit, \$16,300, being the balance of \$50,000. Greensboro, for rental of temporary quarters for post-office and United States Court, \$5,000; Marine Biological laboratory, Beaufort, in Representative Thoma's district, for completion of wharves, piers, jetties and general improvements, \$5,000. The bill also carries \$50,000 for three life-saving stations, two in Representative Thoma's district and one in Representative Small's district."

This Congressional District does not suffer so badly in the big cut in the committee's report of the sundry civil bill, thanks to our Congressman, Charles R. Thoma.

Death of I Erwin Avery.

The news of the death of I Erwin Avery, on last Saturday, local editor of the Charlotte Observer, was a shock to this writer, as it must have been to every one who was personally acquainted with this brilliant young journalist. He was a man who commanded the respect and highest regards and was popular every where he was known. His death seems most untimely and deplorable, and his loss is one which is felt by the Press of North Carolina, and his going leaves a special sadness among those who knew and loved him for himself.
