PAID IN CONFEDERATE MONEY.

Peculiar Story Said to Have Been Told in Norfolk by Portuguese.

A strange and incredible story appear-ed in the Releigh papers yesterday. It was reported from Norfolk that some Portuguese isborers en route from this city to New Bedford, Mass, went to the Mayor's office in Norfolk and told him that they had been imposed on by their employers here who paid their wages in Confederate money. The item said that their story would be investigated and if found to be true the persons thus deceiv ing the ignorant people would be dealt with to the extent of the law.

The story has all the ear marks of a roor-back. None of the men who employed the Portuguese were mean enough to play such a trick. The majority of them were too sharp to be caught by bad money; moreover they are sufficiently onto the wiles of this wicked world to play a trick or two themsel-

As is well known the experiment of engaging Portuguese labor in this secu tion has proved an expensive failure. It was thought that the islanders would make good farm hands and mill help but the proprietors of both mill and farm were disappointed and gradually the dark skinned natives of Cape Verde have drifted back to New Bedford where there is a colony of their country pec-

There are two theories in regard to the Confederate money parn. One is that some negroes taking advantage of the Portuguese ignorance had played a "green goods" trick on them; I. c. selling a lot of useless and illegal money for a small amount of good money Another is that they gave the Mayor of Norfolk a kind of hard luck story in order to get money to help them to their

Mr Geo Headerson tells the Journal that the Portuguese who left on \$ 10 b a. have nearly all purchased their tickets clear through to New York, and could have no object in making such a plea unless they had intended to deceive. When they left New Bern they were well supplied with good money. The Norfolk papers do not mention the circumstance.
