DAMAGE BY HAIL

Truckers Have Sustained Usual Losses This Year.

Next Harvest in Roll. Estimate. The weather has been very favorable for the cotton and corn. Distillers are busy with work.

Raleigh June 14--A charter is granted the Bryan County bank, at Waynesville, capital stock \$10,000. The corporation commissioner authorizes this bank and also the bank of Asheville, to begin business.

The Agricultural & Mechanical College is being put in shape for occupancy by the teachers who will next month attend the summer school. Last year very few buildings were occupied by teachers.

The cool weather is said by farmers to be particularly hard on cotton and corn. It is said there has been frost in the past two days in the mountain regions of this State.

The revenue officials are informed of the establishment of a new whiskey distillery in this county, with a capacity of ten barrels a day. The full season of the distillery is now beginning as a number of them suspend during the summer months.

In an interview with Secretary E. A. Taylor of the Growers' Hall Insurance Company, inquiries were made as to the effect of last storm in the trucking industry. Mr. Taylor said that his company has done business this season in 30 counties, in all of which more or less damage was done by hail about the same as last year.

FORT ARTHUR ATTACK

To Begin Friday, Russian Commander Leads His Leg.

St. Petersburg, June 14--A report has just reached here that a great naval battle was fought outside of Port Arthur June 13th. General Spang, who is in command of the Russian troops at the Port, was wounded, and one of his legs has been amputated at the thigh.

Rome June 14--The Tokio correspondent of the Courier Della Sera, says that foreign attaches are leaving the Japanese capital for the Kwang Tung peninsula, which they hope to reach on Friday as a decisive attack on Port Arthur by the Japanese is expected to begin that day.

Chester, June 14--While the Japanese transport Tatsuomaru was lying at the entrance to Port Arthur harbor yesterday evening one of the mines exploded, killing one officer and eighteen men and wounding two of the officers and seven privates.
