SMALL POX REPORT

Shows Large Number Cases Not
Many Deaths.

Republicans Leaving For Chicago
Conventions. Mystic Shriner
Farmers Institute. Nights
Here Favorable For
Crops.

Raleigh, N. C., June 17th.—The report of the State Board of Health on small pox will show that for the twelve month ending May 31 there were 2,900 cases of the disease in North Carolina, the largest number in any year since the disease made its appearance in January, 1898. The number of deaths was the smallest during any season. For the first time there were more cases among the whites than among the negroes, the number of white cases being 2,800 against 1,000 colored. The total number of cases since the disease made its appearance in this State is nearly 18,000. It is thought the disease in all probability came here from Mexico, being brought from that country by railway employees.

Tomorrow the Republican leaders in this city, including Revenue Collector Dunca, post-master Bailey and District attorney Skinner will leave for Chicago. Over 200 were present. Excellent speeches were made by Judge John B. Gary and Jacob Dutton of Columbia, S. C., Adjt. General Soyaker, Walter L. Liddell, Rev. J. J. Carden of Durham and others. There were 24 candidates for initiation, of which 20 appeared. It is said there are now over 800 Shriner in North Carolina. The banquet was given by Oats Temple.

Those who expect to go will confer a favor by purchasing their tickets not later than Wednesday as the number of tickets will regulate the order of departure.

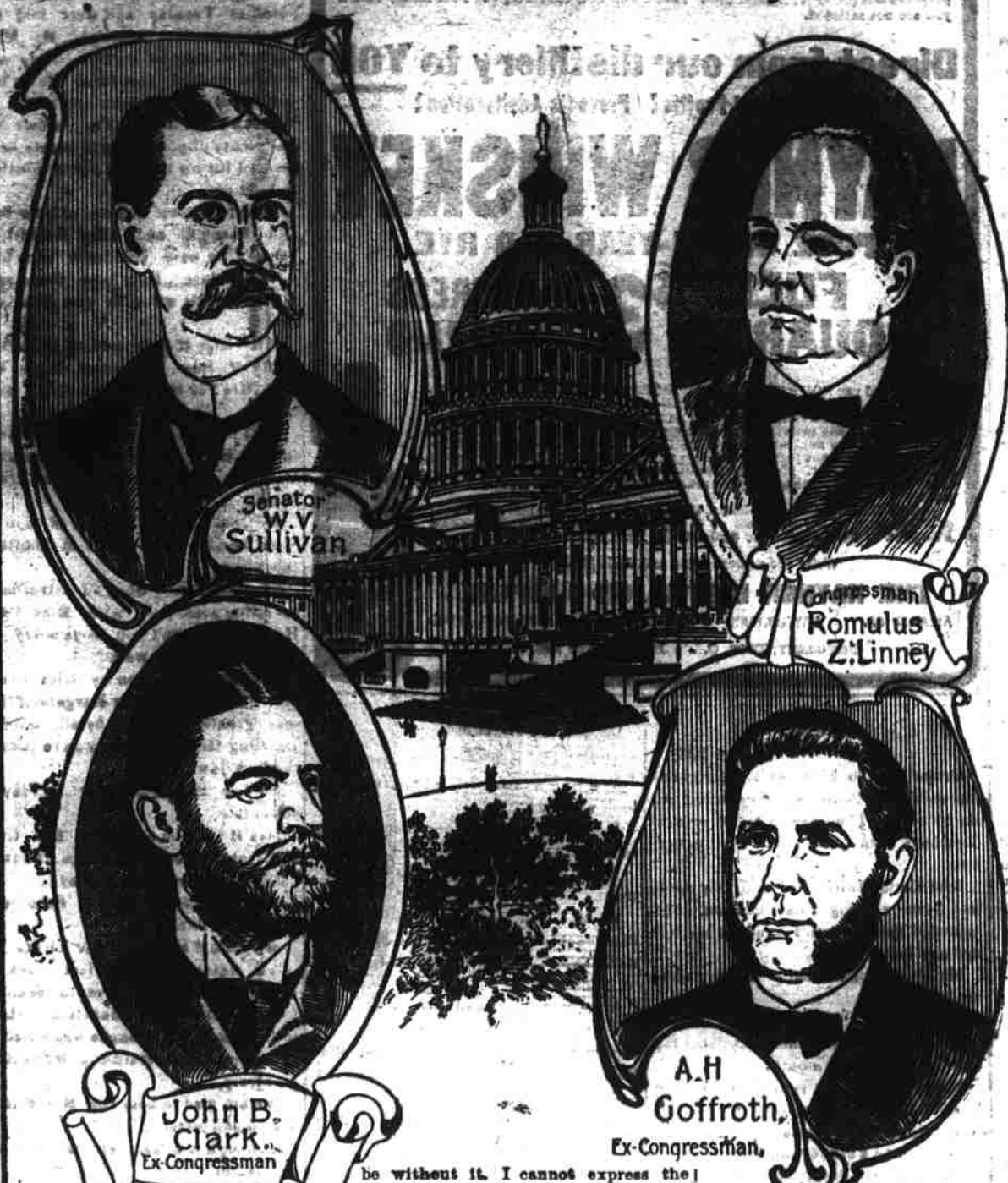
