BID FOR A N. C.

R. S. Holland of Asheville Promises to Promote Great Interests if he Gets the Road.

Raleigh, July 8—Governor Aycock this afternoon announced that R. S. Holland of Asheville was here to see whether he would make bid for lease of Atlantic and North Carolina railway. Theodore F. Davidson being Holland's attorney. They had conference with the Governor today, and will have another tomorrow. The Governor said he could not yet give terms of bid.

Col Davidson said Holland was a man of means, very public spirited, great developer of Electric Railways and suburban properties at Asheville, and that next after George Vanderbilt, he had been a most useful man to the mountain section. He said Holland's plan, if his bid was accepted to thoroughly equip and overhaul the road, and if possible to induce the general government to aid in deepening the bar at Morehead City. Holland is looking forward to the time when all that delta section of North Carolina will be a vast truck garden.

Ferdinand Ulrich, Dead.

It was a severe shock to the family, relatives and friends of Ferdinand Ulrich to receive word yesterday morning of his death in the hospital in Baltimore where he had been taken a few days previously, and where he had cheerfully and courageously undergone a successful operation. But the reaction came Sunday night, and the first telegram noted an alarming condition of the patient, the second told of his death, 3 a m Monday.

Ferdinand Ulrich was a man devoted to his family, and his many loving acts will ever be remembered by those near the bedside which he has left forever. He had fine business talents, and was unusually faithful to the fraternal orders, in which he held high office, and where his friends were in the hundreds.

On June 29th, Mr Ulrich passed his 52nd year. He leaves a wife, daughter and son. His sisters are Mrs Geo W Howard and Mrs John L Cooper. His brothers, Rodolph, Paul T and Louis Ulrich.

He was very Eminent Grand Commander of the Grand Commandery Knights Templar, of North Carolina. He was also a leading member in the following: St John's Lodge A F and A M; New Bern Chapter, York Right Masons; St John's Commandery, E. T.; Oast Temple Noble Mystic Shrine; Consistory and 14 lodges comprising, 88 degrees; Bureau Lodge, I O O F, No 7; Calumet Encampment; Royal Arcanum; and E P O E.

Upon his death, the Grand Commandery of Baltimore took charge of the remains, and a Sir Knight will arrive here this evening in charge, and the funeral services will be held at the residence of Mrs. Ulrich. A number of delegates will be here to officiate and render due honor to their Eminent Commander.

The funeral service will be held Wednesday August 10th at 11 a m at Centenary M E Church.

AFTER FOUR YEARS.

Nick Rogers Captured. Escaped Before Trial in 1900, Wanted For Distilling.

Deputy U. S. Marshal R W Ward made an important capture on Sunday morning about 2 a m, in the person of J. N. Rogers, better known as Nick Rogers, the capture being made about nine miles from Newport, in Carteret county.

In June 1900, Nick Rogers with his brother Jim, was arrested under the statute for removing and concealing spirits upon which no tax had been paid the government. This charge is mostly known as illicit distilling, there being illicit work done before the moving etc, took place.

Before his trial came up Nick Rogers escaped, while his brother Jim was tried in the Federal Court and in October 1902, was sentenced to three years in the penitentiary and a fine of \$500. He is now serving his sentence.

The case of Nick went along with captives being issued time and again, all being returned, with not found. The case was finally nolprosed, and Nick learned this, and it is said has been quite open in his movements, so much so that word finally reached Judge Parnell that Nick was again in business, distilling without the formality of taking out a license. Upon this, the judge ordered the case re-instated on the docket, and Deputy Ward was given the order to take Rogers, which he did, Sunday, as above noted, and for which the Deputy Marshal deserves good credit, as Rogers was a difficult fellow to capture.

Rogers gave \$400 bond for his appearance at the next term of the Federal Court.
