To make five gallons of beer use four pounds of mait, a pound of hops, two pounds of brown sugar, a quart of West India moisses, a reast cake and seven gallons of water. Place the hope and the mait in the water and boil gently for four or five hours. Put in the moissess and let boil fifteen minutes longer. Btrails out the hope and the mait, squeezing them as dry as possible. Mossure the lippor. Vet the sugar and the yeast in enough we set to make up the five gallons. Strain into a keg; let stand open overnight. The next morning cork tightly, and in three days one bear is reasy to usus.
