Curator Brimley Visits Lake Ellis to Secure Them

Raleigh, May 19.—Curator Brimley of the State Museum returned today from a special trip to Lake Ellis, near New Bern. He was after alligators and secured the heads and skins of eight, the largest 8 feet in length. The skins are to be shown and the heads mounted. The water in the lake is only 2 feet deep at most. The alligators were mainly speared, but some were shot, the 25 calibre expanding bullets litterly smashing their skulls. Many photographs were taken, and a number of reptiles and birds were secured.
