HOLDERS OF OLD BONDS

If Rhode Island Turns the Gift Down These Representatives Say That the Holders Will Seek to Induce Other States and Some of the South American Republics to Sue.

Providence, R. I., Jan. 18.—The holders of the repudiated North Carolina bonds will seek to induce other states and some of the South American republics to sue if Rhode Island repudiates the act which makes it compulsory of it to accept a gift of \$511,000 worth of certificates and bring legal action to recover the amount due.

This announcement came from Edward A. L. Andrews, of New York City, representing a large number of bond holders throughout the country, at a hearing before the judiciary committee of the Senate this afternoon on the question of repealing the law and sending back the bonds.

GREAT BRIDGE IS COMPLETED

First Passenger Train Traversed This Remarkable Structure Sunday.

Norfolk, Va., January, 17th, 1910.—Announcement by the Norfolk & Southern Railway of the opening of the 28,000-foot bridge across the Albemarle Sound on yesterday is probably the most important announcement affecting Norfolk and Eastern North Carolina that has been made since the railroad was built.

The Albemarle Sound bridge is one of the most important engineering feats that has been undertaken in the history of the south, and means much for the commercial and industrial development of that section of Eastern North Carolina that has heretofore been cut off from the centers of trade by the great expanse of water which has required the transfer of all passenger and freight trains on the historic Steamer "Garrett".

Work was begun in earnest on Feb. 20th, 1909, and the actual number of working days in building both prior to and since the Resubmission, was three hundred and sixty-five.

The completion of the Albemarle Sound bridge has required more than three hundred cars of lumber, nearly one thousand cars of piles, two hundred and fifty cars of steel, a train load of spikes and bolts and nearly three hundred and sixty-five days extra labor.
