> Dispatches from Baltimore, Kansas City, Omaha, Memphis. Pittsburg and other cities told of the rapid growth of the meat fast.

> Cleveland credited with being the originator of the scheme, now has thirty thousand names enrolled while Kansas City reports eighty thousand.

The heads of the leading packing houses of Kansas City and Chicago refused to discuss the effect of the movement on their business.
