Washington, March 26.-The report issued today shows the total supply of cotton for the six months period, end ing February 26th to have been 11, 2552,361 running bales, made up as fol lows: 1,483,585 held September 1,1909; ginned during period, 9,974,998, net imports, 93,778; the distribution is 2,526,983 bales consumed 3,599,682, ex ported 1,674,831, held in mills 1,932 521 in independent warehouses and other stocks, 818,844.
