JURY RETURNS WITH VERDICT

Case of The City of New Bern vs. Enoch Wadsworth Brought to a Close.

When Superior Court convened yesterday morning the case of the city of New Bern vs Enoch Wadsworth and others in which the defendants claimed damages for land which was assessed by the city was called. All during the morning the counsel on both sides laid their case before the jury, and shortly after 12 o'clock the jury retired and a recess was taken.

When court convened at 2:30 o'clock the jury was called in and the following verdict:

That the city pay to the following named persons the amounts that follow each name: Noah Powell \$900, E. Wilson and wife \$175, Lucinda Stanley \$175, Enoch Wadsworth \$500 and M. L. Hollowell and wife \$400.

There were no other cases on the day's docket and court was adjourned until Monday morning, when the second week's session will begin.
