PRISONERS MAKE THEIR ESCAPE

Two Negroes, Charged With Murder Get Away From Deputy Sheriff After Arrival At Wilmington

Wilmington, May 19—Washington Alexander, a negro, about twenty two years of age, who, with Charles Goodman, is charged with having murdered Hugh Gorner, colored, at the lumber camp of the Norfolk Lumber Company, at Wallace, Sunday morning, made his escape from Deputy Sheriff Bordeaux, of Pender county, immediately after the arrival of the A. & Y. train here last night. The two alleged murderers made their escape Sunday, but were arrested this morning at Parkersburg and were being brought to Wilmington and were to be placed in jail at Burgaw tomorrow. Alexander and Goodman were tied together with a rope, and the former managed to get the knot untied. Gorner was beaten to death with a fence rail, his face having been battered to a pulp. The Norfolk Lumber Co. offered a reward of \$25 for the arrest of Alexander.

First Peaches

BLACK MOUNTAIN.

Remarkable Development of This Favorite Resort.

There is no part of the mountain country that has shown greater improvement than the Black Mountain section. This section includes the great religious centres of Montreat and Bloumont, the Y. M. C. A. and now the probable establishment of a Methodist Chataugua. The township has spent \$30,000 on macadam roads during the past year, radiating in five directions from the town. One road goes to Montreat with its two big hotels and hundreds of cottages.

Among the proposed great mountain highways for automobiles, such as the one from Charlotte to Knoxville, is one proposed to be built from Asheville to the Blowing Rock country, passing through Black Mountain. A trolley line has already been surveyed from Asheville to Black Mountain.

The Inn at Black Mountain will be opened in June by Mrs. W. D. Sprague, who has always been identified with the town. The Inn is the ideal location for a summer outing. The local papers say that all the resorts will be full this summer.

Large Berries

One of the largest strawberries ever seen here was shown the writer by Horace Duncan, a colored farmer, who resides a few miles from the city.

The berries were very large, and one of them measured 4 1/2 inches in circumference and 2 1/2 inches in length. Duncan stated that he had found other berries in his garden that were larger than the one he exhibited, but that they were not in a state of perfect preservation.
