

Policy.

Washington, D. C., July 7-That at least three, and perhaps more, of the Central and South American republics will make a concerted protest of some gind at the coming international conference of American States at Buenas Ayres against the Central American policy of the United States is the possibility being discussed in diplomatic circles bere.

Rumors to this effect have been peristent of late in quarters usually well nformed, and some responsible Latin American representatives admitted their approximate truth, though none would permit himself to be quoted. The rumors have led to a lively exchange of information among the Central and South American diplomats here. Officials of the State Department are known to be watching the situation

Some of the more radical of the Spansh-Americans are said to be in favor of Latin-American alliance against the United States. It is generally conceded, however that formal action of this nature is unlikely.

The most that can be regarded as probable is that the republics interest ed will give the United States to under stand diplomatically that the principle represented in the attitude of this governmemt on the east cost of Nicaragua will not be accepted willingly as a part of the international law of the Ameri-
