INLAND WATERWAY VITAL QUESTION

Raleigh, N. C., Aug. 16.—In discussing the inland waterway and the question that is now uppermost as to whether the old Dismal Swamp canal or the Albemarle canal shall be selected as the course for the waterway, Colonel J. Bryar Grimes, secretary of state, said today:

The old fight that for several generations has been waged between the Albemarle and Chesapeake canal and the Dismal Swamp canal bids fair to be settled at the meeting in Norfolk September 6, when the government will have a hearing of the interests represented by the two canals.
