Bumper Crops For 1910 Are Reported

Washington, Nov. 11-Bumper crops, ed by corn with the greatest harvest ever gathered, where produced by the farmers of the United States during this year. In a general review of crop conditions issued today the bureau of statistics of the Department of Agrieniture says:

"The harvests of 1910 have been practically completed, with results ex ceeding the expectations during the growing period. Preliminary estimates have been made of the production of most of the important crops, from which it appears that the aggregate product ion of crops in 1910 are approximately 7.6 per cent, greater than the crops of 1909, and about 9.1 per cent, greater than the average annual production of the preceding five years. Prices for important crops averaged on November 1 about 5.4 per cent, lower than a year
