This country's prosperity or depression forecasts have emana ted for such a long period from that speculative center, and so of ten proven true, that the men who would further their own financial ends, per Wall street forecast, have held their opinions as being without appeal. The Hill forecast has the mark of Wall street, not based upon actualities, but has for its purpose personal if hot more and industrial conditions may be affected. There are philanthropists in the world, but they never were found in the speculative marts. Pessimism is not natural to the owner and possessor of bank stocks railroads and great land holdings, for such possessions only come through eptimism of a high order. Therefore when the millionaire, the banker, the railroad president gives warning of unsafe public conditions, it is time for the people to heed. But Mr. Hill does not warn, he is a Jeremiah preaching positive destruction. His business ac tion of buying 245,000 tons of rails for his Great Northern Road last year is not in keeping with his present pessimistic declaration. He is crying a financial wolf warning that is not possible to arrive, and largely it must appear for some personal object. The basis for this country's prosperity, the crops, are great and valuable. There is work for those who will accept employment. There are signs of national legislation that will further the interests of the people.
