Washington, Feb. 24—On leaving the White House and after a talk with President Taft, Senator Clapp, of Minneota, expressed the opinion that an extra assion of Congress could not now be avoided, owing to the crowded condition of things in the Senate, the opposition to certain measures and lack of time for the proper consideration of important measures that a number of Senators insist shall not be rushed through without proper investigation.

The statement is going the rounds that Senator La Follette is protesting loudly against the passage in the House in a single day of three appropriation bills.

The Wisconsin insurgent is said to have served notice that these measures must not only be carefully considered.

must not only be carefully considered by Senate committees before they are reported, but he and his political associates intend that they shall be looked into carefully and discussed after the bills are taken up in the Senate.

Altogether the situation affords ample opportunity for certain Senators to get in what is called in legislative cirles "underground" work -they can dey matters and score without appearing to unnecessarily delay progress of bills and agreements favored by the Taft Administration.
