About 1855 Alfred Nobel, a Swedish engineer, learned how to explode the liquid by detonation. Nobel Bros. of Hamburg that year sent a goung man to America to introduce its use to miners. He met with no success, and a tin can of the liquid left by him in a New York hotel when thrown into the street wrecked the hotel, injuring many and causing the neighborhood to rain glass.

It was known commercially at this stage as "glonion" and blew up by accident a West Indies packet at Colon. killing fifty people and destroying property worth a million dollars. Then burn at certain temperatures if the quantity is small. When exploded it instantly expands 10,000 times; the gases require 10,000 times the space

of the liquid. At last Nobel learned to soothe and quiet the liquid by causing it to be absorbed in infusorial earth. It was this preparation that in 1866 was called dynamite by Nobel When it explodes the force plunges first downward and then rebounds upward. Unless confined it has little tendency to lateral pres sure. This is one of its great peculiar ities. Louisville Courier Journal.
