



"Laughter," says Professor Sir Charies Bell, "Is a convulsive action of the disphragm. In this state the person draws a full breath and throws it out in interrupted short and audible cachinnations. This convulsion of the diaphragm is the principal part of the physical manifestation of laughter.

"But there are several accessories especially the sharp vocal derance arising from the violent tension of the larvex and the expression of the features, this being a more intense form of the smile. In extreme cases the eyes are moistened by the effusion from the lachrymal glands."

There are some people who cannot laugh, who are wholly unable to enjoy either the physical or the mental luxury of a laugh. Thus it was said of William III. that he was utterly at a loss to understand what could be got out of laughter except loss of dignity.
