Freight Train Ordinance.

Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the city of New Bern:

Section 1 That no freight cars shall be shifted, and no freight trains shall be made up on Queen street in the City of New Bern, West of the Eastern Line of Graves Street. Nor shall said street west of said eastern line of Graves street be used, for shifting freight cars, or operating a train of cars for that purpose, or the purpose of making up of freight trains.

Section 2 Every person who shall engage in the doing, or performance of the acts forbidden by this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and, on conviction thereof be fined fifty dollars for each offence.

Section 3 This Ordinance shall be enforced after thirty days from the date of its adoption. Sept. 5th, 1911.
