STOVES OF IRON.

They Superseded the Roman Stove in the Eighteenth Century.
A heating apparatus called a "stove" (stove) was widely used among the higher class of Romans before the beginning of the Christian era. This class of heaters was fixed and immovable, besides being in several other respects wholly different from the modern stove. In Germany and Scandinavia they were used in bathhouses and hotouses during the middle ages. They were usually constructed of brick, stone or tile and were of immense size. They sometimes covered the whole side of a twenty or thirty foot room and often extended out into the room as much as ten feet, in which case the smooth, flat top was used for a bedstead, the heated surface imparting an agreeable feeling of warmth during those cold nights of long ago when such things as covers were quite rare.

Cardinal Polignac of France was perhaps the first to attempt the construction of a stove wholly of iron, this at about the beginning of the eighteenth century. The first real improvement over the old Roman "stove" was brought about by Franklin in the year 1745. One of his efforts produced a typical base burner, almost perfect and a model of workmanship. Stoves were not used in private houses to any great extent prior to the year 1830.—London Standard.

London's Muffin Man.
The muffin man had no monopoly of the street bell when William IV. was king, as John Ashton records in a sketch of that time. The dustman also rang a bell and yelled, and the postman's bell was a most popular institution. There were no pillar boxes in those days, and the sound of the bell brought people who lived far from a postoffice to their doors to give the postman their letters to post. "Pickwick," however, we have evidence that even then the muffin man was chief among hand bell ringers. For when the town crier of Eatonsville proclaimed silence on the bustings by "a conchero on the bell" a gentleman in the crowd called "Muffins!"—London Mail.
