CROCODILES IN WATER.

Practically Invisible Themselves, They See, Hear and Breaths.

The crocodiles are thoroughly aquatic in their habits, and their peculiar conformation enables them to attack and seize their prey unawares. Their nostrils, which lead by a long canal to the back part of their throats, their eyes and their ears, are placed on the upper part of the head, so that when in the water they can breathe, see and hear, while they are themselves practically invisible. When they dive their nostrils and ears are closed by lids or valves, and their eyes are covered by a transparent nictitating membrane. They are further furnished with an arrangement which prevents the water from getting down their own throats when they are folding large animals

under the water to drown them. The dentition of these reptiles is pecultar. The teeth are sharp and conical and are hollow at the base, and each tooth serves as the sheath of an other, which will in time replace it.
