






Owen G. Dunn Heads New Newspresentatives of North Carolina afpapers met here Saturday night for the purpose of forming a North Carolina circuit for press re-ports. Those present were Owen G. Donn of The New Bern Sun, J. L. Horne, Jr., or the Rocky Mount Tele-gram, J. M. Reece of The Greensbore Record. J. F. Hurley of The Salis buryPost and S. J. Flickinger of the Darham San. Letters were received from the editors of The Wilmington Dispatch, The Wilson Tim's and The Concord Tribune saying that it was impossible for them to be present, but that they were to be count d on in the organization.

The different phases of the press service were discussed at length, and plans for getting an inapraved service were gone into thoroughly... WHITELAW REID DEAD

American Ambassador To Great Britain Passes Away.

London, Dec. 16 .- Whitelaw Reid, the American ambassador to Great Britian since 1905 died at his London residence, Dorchester house, shortly after noon yesterday from pulmonary oedma. The end was quite peacful. Mrs. Reid and their daughter, Mrs. John Hubert Ward, were at the bed-

The ambassador had been unconsious since 9 o'clock in the morning and at intervals during the previous 4 hours he had been slightly delirious as a result of the drugs administered to ind or sleep.

Sir Thomas Bartow, physician to the King, who was called in last week after Mr. Reid's illness became acute and his regular physician, Dr. William Hale White, issued the following bulletin as to the cause of death:

"A fortnight ago the American ambassador had a slight bronical attack similiar to others which he had suffered at considerable intervals. On Wednes-day has, asthma supervened and the asthmatic paroxysms became very severe, leading to extreme exhaustion. "It was hoped that he might rally; as no pneumonic symptoms had appeared. With difficulty the paroxysms of asthma were gotten under control, but Sunday morning the exhaustion beand axtreme and he died from pulmenary bedeing at 12:10 p. m."
