Fall and Winter Pastures. There is no department of farming that requires more thought than providing fall and winter pasture.

where the raising of sheep and young stock is a part of the system adopted.

It is almost impossible to be a successful farmer without this branch of industry.

To cheaply winter sheep and young calves, colts and mules, nothing the farmer can resort to will pay better than rye sown among corn in September and October.

Light stock is pastured on this during the fall and winter, where the land is to be planted in corn or potatoes, especially corn, will not materially injure it by tramping.

It is a cheap and easy made pasture. One bushel of rye will be enough seed per acre, and a few bushels of a bushel will, if sown in the early part of September, make fine growth by the first of December, when sheep can be put on it to graze.

It is cheaper than corn, oats or hay, and saves much labor in feeding, besides keeping stock in better condition.

I do not think that the sowing of rye for fall and winter grazing can be too earnestly urged. The plan, if once adopted, will not be surrendered as long as sheep and young stock constitutes (as it should) a part of the system of farming.
