The wheat crep in our State has been harvested under most unfavorable circumstances. Mach de to was sprouted and cathe damaged. Proper precaution a be taken as doubtless this pes be unusually active. And there is danger from the moundation of the grain, that it where marks.

Frepare scaffolds, cover with sheets and put out the warm about four inches in depth. Let it have the fuil sunshine during all the warm part of the day—any from nine in the forences to four in the afterneon, stirring it theroughly three or four times. Have your boxes, hogsheads or bins thoroughly cleaned out and ready to receive the grain. Air them and sun them thoroughly. They should be as het as the sun can make them at the time the wheat is put in them.

Pour it up while it is hot, mixing with it a handful of salt or lime to every three bushels. The wheat will keep sound and we have had


