The greatest truths are the simplest; and so are the greatest men; and women, too, for that matter.

It is chiefly by nourishing the higher nature that the lower is kept in controlled and orderly operation. The more fully men are engrossed in what is true and pure and worthy of all their powers and and intelligence, the more naturally and easily will appetite, passion and desire assume a proper subservience, and fulfill their assigned functions quietly and legitimately. When they are forced to the front, brought up for constant review, and made the theme of much conversation and discussion, of alternative approval and censure, they occupy the place of other and weightier things and lose their harmonious relations.

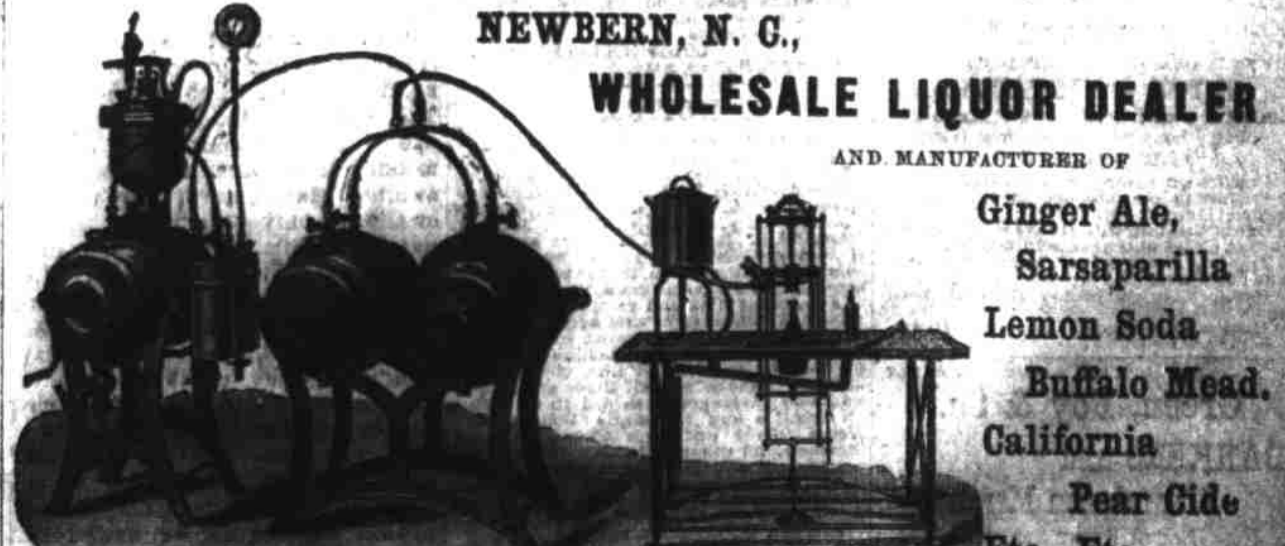
