OFFICE REGISTER OF DEEDS, CRAVEN CO., NEWBERN, June 27th, 1888.

All Merchants, Traders, Liquor Dealers, Keepers of Ferries, Commission Merchants, Auctioneers, and all others in Craven county who are required to list their purchases, receipts or sales, under Schedule "B" of the Revenue Laws of North Carolina, are hereby notified to list the same with the undersigned at his office during the FIRST TEN DAYS IN JULY, 1888. The said lists must contain all purchases or receipts, as the case may be, for six months ending June 30, 1888, and should be sworn to and subscribed before the Register of Deeds.

All persons failing to list before the 10th of July will be subject to a double tax.
