Proceedings of County Commissioners. The Board convened Tuesday morning, January 7, at 10 o'clock.

Ordered that the property listed to Graham Daves, in township No. 8, valued at \$4,715, and \$200 increase be stricken from tax list.

Ordered that the tax assessed against W. Washington Bryan, in No. 8 township, on \$800 increase tax, be reduced from 1 to 1/2 per cent.

Ordered that the valuation of land listed to G. S. Rowe, in No. 2 township, be reduced from \$155 to \$100.

Ordered that all persons claiming any reduction of their taxes, by error or otherwise, shall submit the claim in writing, setting forth all the facts connected therewith to the Board.

Ordered that 25 acres of land listed to D. A. Moore, in township No. 8, be stricken from the list, the same having been listed in supplemental list.

The order to issue license to John D. Dinkins to sell liquor in New Bern was rescinded, by consent of Dinkins, and license was granted to Asher and Hardison to sell liquor at the same place.

The Board took a recess and met again at 3 o'clock p. m.

The jury for the February term of Craven county Superior court was drawn. (Printed elsewhere).

The Board adjourned.
