Sixteen Persons Drowned and Three

Crushed to Death in a Collision LONDON. Oct. 26.-The British steamer Boston, from Cardiff for London, has arrived at Falmouth after having been in collision with the British bark Charlwood, 759 tons, Capt. Salmon, from Antwerp to Valparaiso. The Charlwood foundered almost immediately after the collision with a loss of sixteen lives. Three men were killed on board the Boston at the time of the collision, and the steamer's beats were badly stove in

The captain of the Charlwood, his wife, son, a governess, and the stewardess, together with all the bark's officers and six of the seamen a total of sixteen persons were drowned in spite of the desperate efforts made by the lifeboats of vessels which happened to he near the scene of the collision to rescue them. The efforts of the would-be life savers were greatly hambered by the darkness which prevailed at the time the accident took place -4:45 in the morning The spot where the two vessels met was not far from the Eddystone rocks, fourteen miles from Plymonth. Only an apprentice and the cap-

tain's daughter were saved.

A Button's Journey. John Bowden, fifty five years of Hospital yesterday and complained of a severe pain in his leg. No outward evidence of any injury could be discoverd by the physicians, but, with Bowden's consent, they cut into the centre of pain and removed a large confederate military button. Bowden said that he was wounded in the army at the battle of Gettsburg. but at the time the bullet could not be found, although the wound was probed several times by the hespital physicians. The confec-erate button was the misile that inflicted the wound in his arm, and had worked its way up through his body and down to the place where it was found and removed .-


