PRINCIPLES NOT MEN.
 No man can tell who will be the presidential nominee of the Chicago Convention, but it is comparatively easy to enunciate the cardinal principles that will compose the platform.

Men come and go. The favorite policy may be rejected of tomorrow, but principles are the same yesterday, today and forever. Circumstances may dictate measures, but no measure can have the support of the American Democracy that does not rest on the solid rock of the Constitution as interpreted by Jefferson, Madison and Jackson, and illustrated in the successful administration of Cleveland.

It is usual in Presidential elections for the party in power to assume the defensive, while the opposition party attacks it in its fortified position. The Republicans claim that they have given the country a wise and judicious administration, and the policy of the Harrison administration is justly entitled to the moral endorsement of the people of the United States.

On this the Democrats join issue and assert that the passage of the McKinley bill was in direct opposition to the interest of the people and violation of the principle that government must secure the greatest good to the greatest number. They assert that the bill is in the interest of monopoly; makes the Government a partner in the private business of the few to the detriment of the great mass of the people.

mocks the people who proposes that the Government shall protect the rich, and that they will care for the laboring poor. Any intermediary between the people and their government, or the least delegation of the care and protection the Government owes to the humblest citizen of the land, makes the boast of free institutions a glittering delusion and the pretended boon of American citizenship a shameful imposition.”

The Harrison administration has demonstrated the existence of an organized plan for the permanent association of the Government with the private and personal interests of favored classes of its citizens in the exercise of the sovereign power of taxation, and it is the purpose of the great Democratic party to overthrow it, and restore the Government to its only legitimate object, the welfare and happiness of the people.

The Democratic party is no enemy to manufacturers and tradesman, but its stern command to every tyrant is, “take your heel from the necks of the people.” The Democratic party insists that the only constitutional tariff is a tariff for revenue, and that every dollar taken from the pockets of the people, more than is necessary for the absolute need of the Government economically administered, is public robbery. The McKinley law is a robber tariff and must be repealed. If Harrison is renominated, he will stand on a platform endorsing the Force bill and demanding its passage.

No man can be a Democrat who gives countenance and support to such a measure as the Force bill of the fifty-first Congress. It is in direct opposition to the Bill of Rights, an insult to American manhood, and a parody upon American liberty.

Then, whatever else the Democratic party may do, in national convention, it will antagonize the McKinley tariff law and the Harrison Force bill. Tariff reform, and the restoration of the people to all their rights under the Constitution, will be the grand object of the Democratic party in the approaching campaign.
