A working model of the result breating locomotive, invented and patented by Master Mechanic Jackson Richards, of the Reading Railroad, has been placed on a shibition in the hall of the Budder-Exchange, Philadelphia. A Large number of engineers, becometive experts and others interested in the increase of speed on millroad visited the hall during the day.

"The new inventions will enable a gigantic stride to be taken in the matter of high speed lecomotives and it is more than likely that the time between Philadelphia and New York will be decreased below than an hour. "In outward appearance the comotive will not differ materially from the speedy ones now used by our company between this city and New York. "You can see how smooth and easily the engine works by the model. This, though it has been running 100 miles an hour for over a day, and though it is placed on a moveable support without any fastenings whatever, has not shifted during that time one-six teenth of an inch from its first position.

"An easy way to describe my locomotive would be to say it is two engines consolidated into one so adjusted that when the balance of one's driving wheel is on top that of the other is bene in, and vice versa."
