The danger this summer and full is unusually great. The head lines of a cholera article in the Washington Post, of the 11th, inst., are "Hundreds left unburied. Horrible Districts of Mesca. Unfortunate pilgrims died so rapidly that the grave-diggers could not pile them into the trenches."

This is bad, very bad, but it is no worse than accounts that come from yellow fever infested districts The startling headlines is the news columns read:

"Fever's awful death toll. Thousin Santos. Corpses fill the river. Hundreds of bolies floating with the tide in all stages of decay. Towns depopulated," Then, there is great danger of the introduction of cholera and yellow fever from abroad. But the danger is not confined to this. Cholera or yellow felver may originate any where ment of these complaints without extra that the cause exists. It is believed that the fever that was so fatal at New Berne, years ago, originated there. The writer of this article has seen many cases of cholers and yellow fever, and the most malignant were those that seemed to have there origin in the locality in which they appeared.
