The General Government and the municipal authorities of our principal commercial cities and ports of entry have adopted sanitary regulations to prevent the introduction of malignant, contagious and epidemic diseases, but this precaution, important as it is, does not meet the demands of the situation.

Every man, landlord and tenant must guard his own premises. The danger this summer and fall is unusually great. The head lines of a cholera article in the Washington Post, of the 11th inst., are "Hundreds left unburied. Horrible scenes in the Cholera infected Districts of Mexico. Unfortunate pilgrims died so rapidly that the grave-diggers could not pile them into the trenches."

This is bad, very bad, but it is no worse than accounts that come from yellow fever infected districts. The startling headlines in the news columns read: "Fever's awful deathroll. Thousands dead from the yellow scourge in Santos. Corpses fill the river. Hundreds of bodies floating with the tide in all stages of decay. Towns depopulated." Then, there is great danger of the introduction of cholera and yellow fever from abroad. But the danger is not confined to this. Cholera or yellow fever may originate any where that the cause exists. It is believed that the fever that was so fatal at New Berne, years ago, originated there. The writer of this article has seen many cases of cholera and yellow fever, and the most malignant were those that seemed to have their origin in the locality in which they appeared.
