Such a caucus as we have advocated would solidify the democratic majority and enable it to move forward with unanimity, harmony and intelligent determination. It would end a good deal of the present uncertainty concerning the action of congress, and would make it more difficult for the republiean minority to retard the progress of legislation.

It is estimated at Washington that high water mark in the pension business was reached July the 1st, 1893, nearly thirty years after the war, when there were 996,012 pensioners on the list. The decrease that has since taken place indicatit is said, that there will be a falling off of 50,000 a year by deaths, remarriages of widows, and the coming to non-pensionable age of minor children. New pensions are being granted every day at the rate of about 4,000 per annum, which would indicate a net decrease of 10,000 per annum. But many of the new pensions granted carry back pay, so that no material decrease in the amount expended for pensions is to be looked for at present .- Philadelphia Ledger, Ind.
