RATES ON EXHIBITS TO FAIRS AND EXPOSITIONS.

Shipments of live stock and other property for exhibition at the various County and State Fairs and Expositions, will be transported over the A. & N. C. R. R. on the following terms:

1st. Forwarding agents will require prepayment of freight at full tariff rates on articles intended for exhibition, issning bills of lading and way bills specifying each and every article in detail and freight on each.

2nd. All exhibits transported as above vill be returned free to orriginal shipping point, provided the ownership remains unchanged and the shipment is made within thirty days atter the fair or exposition. and the orriginal bill of lading is surrendered, being endorsed or certified by the proper officer of the fair that the article specified has been duly exhibited.


