





Minnesota Women Try Dress Reform. Declaring that the present styles in Federation of Women's clubs of Minnesota has stated a dress reform which it is proposed to make nation wide

Recently the board wrote to every manufacturer and buyer of ready made clothing for women and to every manufacturer and publisher of dress patterns making an appeal for modification of the present styles. The letter being sent to the clothing manufacturers reads:

"The executive board of the Fourth district of the Minnesota Federation of Women's clubs, at the request of a number of women, ask that, beginning with the next season, there be furnished some very attractive, up to date garments where the width at the bottom of the skirts shall be two yards for a woman of thirty-six inch bust measure, well proportioned, not drawing tight across the form at any part, and reaching within three inches of the shoe; other sizes in proportion.

"Many women under protest have en obliged to use the present styles of ready made clothing, but very many have informed us that they have done without new garments rather than buy such as have been offered during the last few months. We ask for some different styles for modest gentlewomen from those suited to the demimondain
