"Several weeks ago a news item was carried in the Enterprise stating that the Pine Lumber Company was intending clearing up their holdings, in a radius of three miles of their mill, the same distance northeast of this town. Such is being done as rapidly as possible. Already fences enclose the place and the work of clearing the growth is rapidly being done. It is stated that several farms, will be cleared up and that in addition to this, the Company will arrange a large pasture, in which they will raise a quantity of stock, hundreds of cattle, hogs and sheep having already been purchased from the near by farmers, and stock dealers."
