**QUARREL OVER THE
 SITE OF SCHOOL HOUSE**

Trouble Between County Commissioners and School Trustees.

BEAUFORT, July 18.—Just about the time peace and quiet were being established in the municipal family here, and the city fathers had about settled their differences, and had elected city officers which had been held at bay for two or three months because a quorum of the alderman could not be had, there appears a breach between the Board of County Commissioners and trustees of the Beaufort Graded school district. It seems that these two bodies have had joint control of the block on which the county court house stands for a number of years. Two or three of the commissioners created a new court house on one side of the property, and a short while ago the school district voted \$20,000 worth of bonds with which to erect a new school building, and the trustees were going ahead getting plans in shape to begin the erection of the new educational building on the other side of the lot that they supposed belonged to them. But now the Board of County Commissioners come in and to them. But now the Board of County Commissioners comes in and declare that the whole property belongs to the county and that the school trustees have no right to any part of the grounds. County Attorney Davis and Judge O. H. Guion, representing the board declare that Carteret county is the sole owner of the land, and attorneys for the trustees have advised that body to proceed as the title is good. On the other hand the commissioners declare that if work is started without an agreement being reached that they will secure an injunction against the school officials. It is understood that the commissioners profess to have no objection to the building being erected on the grounds, but that they propose to be consulted and an amicable settlement be made. It is hoped that the matter will be arranged at an early date so that work may begin on the new school building.

* There is a lively scrap on among the Democrats of Carteret county at this time. There were two candidates for the office of Sheriff and for Register of Deeds before the county convention which met here in June. Two of the candidates were from the eastern end of the county, a section that has never been represented in the county offices. That section claimed then and does now that they have

saved the county to the Democratic party all along and that they are now entitled to representation, but the two candidates from that section were defeated, and the delegates from down there walked out. Now they declare that unless one of the nominees "comes down" and allows one of the eastern candidates to take his place that they will put up a ticket that can be voted by citizens of all political parties, and thus effect the defeat of the regular Democratic ticket. A meeting of the Democratic committee was held yesterday, and appointed a sub-committee to take the situation under advisement, and will have another meeting today. It is expected that something real interesting will take place at this meeting as the people of the east are thoroughly aroused and are determined to be recognized. It is believed that unless a compromise can be effected that the entire Democratic ticket will be defeated at the election this fall. The eastern people have a large and representative following all over the county.
