Rome, Aug. 20 .- It is expected the inclave for the election of a pope vill be held on September 3, after a lelay to give time for the cardinals from several countries to arrive. Even so, it is doubtful whether Cardinals Gibbons and O'Connell from the United States and Cardinal Cavalcanti from Rio Janeiro can reach here by that time, owing to the partial suspension of the steamship ser-

The rising sun which gilded the image of St. Joseph on the wall by the pontiff bed this morning found Franciscan Plenipotentiaries keeping the dead watch and murmuring prayers. At St. Peter's Square which had been filled throughout the night with persons of every rank until the death of the Pope was announced was deserted. Under the colonades at the bronze door of the Vatican two Italian Carabineers exchanged reports regarding the death of his holiness with the Swiss guards.

Mosignor Zampini, of the Pope's household, assisted by the secretary and the Pontiff's yalet, laid out the body, placed the crucifix in the hands and stationed lighted candles about
