**VANCEBORO FARMERS A PROGRESSIVE SET**

BELIEVE IN MOST IMPROVED METHODS OF FARMING.

Realizing the advantage of irrigation and proper drainage the farmers around the Vanceboro section of Craven county, which incidentally is one of the most productive sections in Eastern North Carolina, are making rapid progress in the adoption of this system and the opening of another season will doubtless find the farms in that section as well, if not better irrigated and drained, than any other part of the county. M. H. Wetherington, the owner and operator of a large brick manufacturing concern at that place was in Newbern yesterday and while here he spoke interestingly of the work in progress there. The farmers are using tiling pipes in draining their land and Mr. Wetherington has recently erected a tile manufacturing plant in connection with his brick works and this is now being worked on full time in order to supply the demand from the many agriculturists in that section. A few years ago the more improved methods of farming were practically unknown in that section. Little by little farm demonstrators and literature from the State Department of Agriculture taught the tillers of the soil how they might increase their products and these methods were readily adopted, at least some of them were and others are being put in force very rapidly. The result of this is that where they ten years ago produced a hundred dollars worth of produce on an acre they are now producing nearly double that amount the section is growing more prosperous each year.

**MANY FISH IN NEW BERN BERN YESTERDAY**

A great quantity of fish passed through New Bern yesterday. A part of them were being shipped from Morehead City and Beaufort to various places over the central part of the state. There was also a large quantity that went through from Norfolk, and quite a number of boxes shipped by the local dealers.

**CHOLERA STRIKES AUSTRIAN TROOPS**

NURSES WHO SERVED IN BALKANS RUSH TO FRONT—VIENNA CLAIMS VICTORY IN SERVIA.

VIENNA, Sept. 15.—The Austrian Red Cross were advised to-day that a number of cases of cholera had been discovered among the soldiers at the front. Nurses who served in the Balkan war have been sent to Galicia and to the Servian frontier because of their experience with cholera. Dysentery is rife among the troops and has even extended to this city as a result of patients brought here. The conditions are not alarming, however, it is officially stated.

An official statement was issued today denying Servian claims of success over Austro-Hungarian troops. "We're invading Servia successfully," the statement says, "Sarajevo is in no danger."
