INNIS MAY GO BACK TO ATLANTA

THAT IS IF TEXAS JURY FAILS TO INDICT HIM

Atlanta, Oct. 1—If the G and J jury in San Antonio, Texas, fails to indict Victor E. Innis, the accused Portland lawyer, and Mrs. Innes on the charge murdering Eloise Nelms Dennis and Beatrice Nelms, indications are that Innes, and probably Mrs. Innes, will be brought to Atlanta to stand trial on Government charges in connection with his affair with Mrs. Dennis.

This news came today in advices from Mrs. Nelms to F. M. Loveless, her business adviser, in which she stated that the Grand Jury will meet next Monday, and District Attorney Linden has set apart the first week for consideration of the Innes-Nelms case. She sent this information following a two hours' conference with the District Attorney, and explained that, in the event of the Grand Jury's failure to indict in Atlanta. No details of this plan were given.

NOTICE OF ELECTION

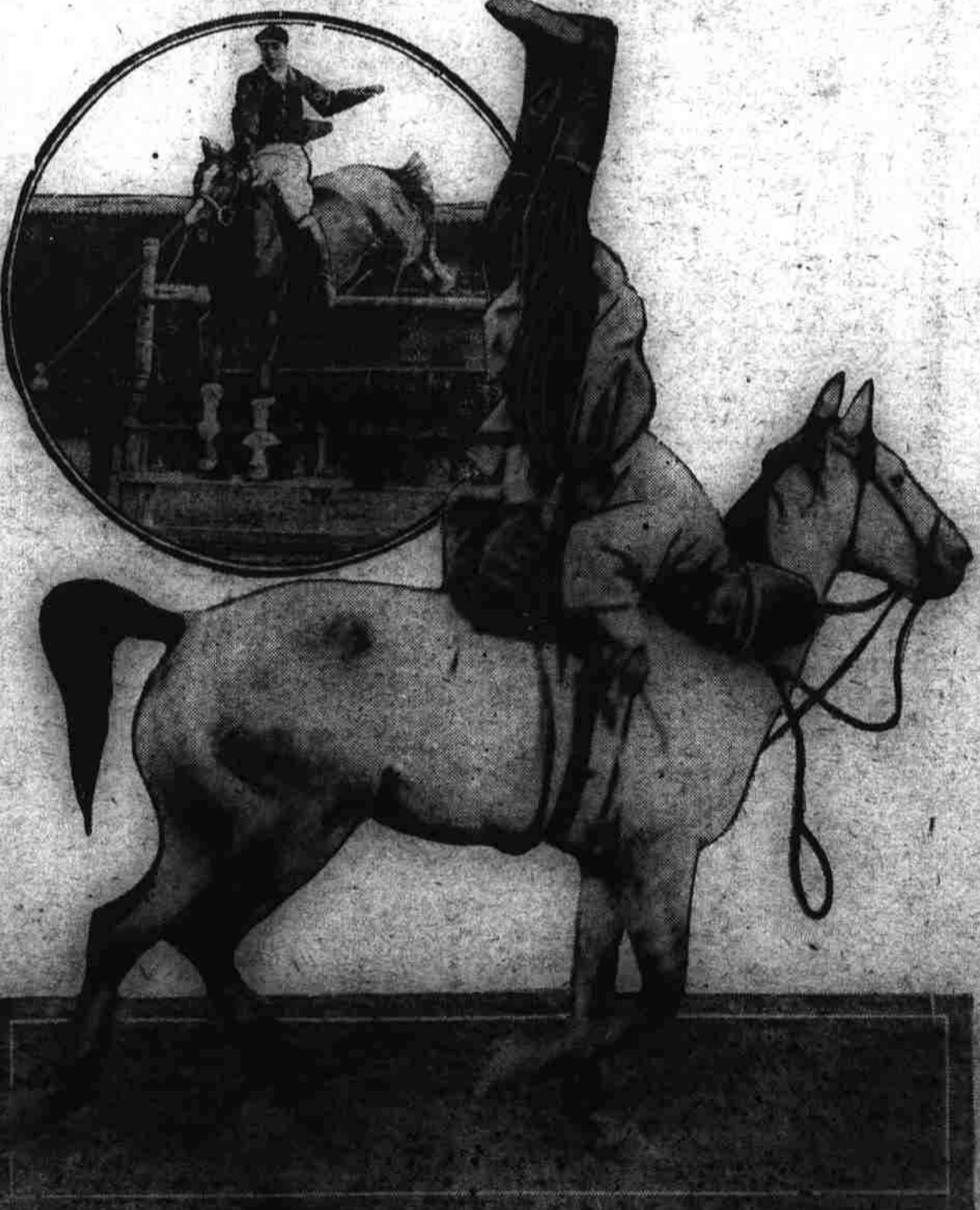
The general election for Congressional, state, district, county and township officers will be held at the polling places in Craven county on Tuesday, Nov. 3, 1914.

Any person may register on any day by applying to the registrar at his home or place of business. On Saturday the registrar will be at the polling place with his book for the purpose of registering any voters who may apply for registration. Saturday, October 31st, the books will be opened for the purpose of challenge only.

The proposed constitutional amendments will also be voted on at said election. Copies of said amendments may be obtained from the registrars in the several precincts, register of deeds, Journal office or Sun office.
