The article, entitled "The Lone Wolf," is one of the series, "Re-Assessment: 1955," which the "New Republic" has been publishing and which re-evaluates older books. Among those contributing to the series have been Malcolm Cowley, Leslie Fiedler, and Leon Edel.

Prof. Holman's article reassesses "Look Homeward, Angel," and takes exception to the standard critical attitude toward the book, concluding, "Unless we demand that all novels be neat and concise, 'Look Homeward, Angel' has much to offer us still."
