Early Report On Planning Due In January

Preliminary report on the new development plan being made for Chapel Hill area is to be submitted to the District Planning Commission about a month.

The five-year-old land use plan. The new job will involve a re-study of population and economic prospects for the community as well as a re-survey of recommended land uses for the entire area. It will also include a dwelling count of the area.

This data will be used to guide the Board in deciding upon requests for changes in various zone restrictions set up under the

new suburban zoning ordinance. Also at its Tuesday meeting the Board approved a recommendation to the aldermen to zone the new Estes Hills development of the Srvic Insurance and Realty Company's into RA-10. The Board approved a subdivision of the area after setting minimum street widths at 40 and 32 feet. In addition, the board received but took no final action on an amendment to streamline re-zoning procedures under the new zoning act.
