Garden Ramblings

—AROUND CHAPEL HILL—

If it is true that we can expect a cold winter with a lot of bad weather this year, then indoor gardening will become even more popular. Many people seem to have trouble with their house plants. I never seem to go out to dinner without somebody saying, "Oh, you're a gardener. Then you can tell me what is the matter with my African Violet." Usually this requires second sight since the plant may even be in another town. Seriously though I am always happy to help with plant problems if I can.

light, temperature, air, water and soil—that affect plant life are clearly written and most helpful. I particularly welcomed the chapter, START WITH THE SOIL because this is the thing that most of us overlook in the first place. The soil for pot plants should contain plenty of peat of leafmould so that there is adequate drainage. This chapter does not overlook suitable plant fertilizers too. The biological factors of pests and diseases, another scourge of house plants is covered in the chapter BUGS AND BLIGHTS. Other chapters are devoted to the many that you can grow in the house—besides African Violets.

This is a very useful book and well worth more than 75 cents to you if you follow Mr. Exerett's advice. The illustrations are clear.

At the drug store recently I picked up a 75 cent book on HOW TO GROW BEAUTIFUL HOUSE PLANTS by Thomas H. Everett of New York Botanical Garden. This book seems to have all the information that you will require to grow your house plants. The chapters on the five physical factors—
