## Decisive Test.

Dear Sir: Owing to questions as to the relative strength of the bricks made here in the two yards, and wanting to be assured myself—wanting a reliable brick to stand heavy pressure—I made a thorough test of their different characteristics for this purpose.

The bricks were taken by myself from the two yards, and were a fair sample. The one from your yard stood a crushing weight of 1,000 lbs. per square inch, without crushing. The one from Dean's crushed in a powder at 450 lbs.

Your brick weighed dry, 4 lbs. 7 oz.

After soaking all night in water, your brick weighed 4 lbs. 11 oz. Dean's weighed 4 lbs. 4 oz.
