THE SECOND VICTIM.

The second victim of electrocution in the State of New York, as appears now, is to be Shibuya Jugi-ro, a Japanese, now confined in Sing Sing prison under sentence of death for murder. The state of the case is as follows: It was sought to secure Jugi-ro's release on habeas corpus on the ground the Kemmer case had demonstrated that electricity was a cruel and unusual punishment, and as such is prohibited by the constitution. Chief Justice Fuller announced the decision of the court. The court affirmed the judgment upon the authority of the decision in the Kemmer case. There was no written opinion, and the court did not go into consideration of the points raised by Jugi-ro's counsel, holding that so far as the Federal question was concerned the case did not differ from that of Kemmer. This it is believed, destroys the last legal resort of the counsel for Jugi-ro.
