The building was watched closely, and about 11 o'clock last night the wall fell and the building which was worth about \$2,000 is almost a complete wreck.

The building was owned by Messrs Burns and Mills and is supposed to be well insured: Messrs. Bennett Bro's. goods were damaged about \$1,500 by the falling wall and the rain which set in early this morning.


