ENTERED AT THE POST-OFFICE IN GREENSBORO AS SECOND-CLASS MATTER.

Brick Building Gaves In. WADESBORO, N. C. Feb. 18.—[Special to Charlotte Chronicle]—The nice two story brick building occupied by Bennett Bros. for general merchandise store, and adjoining the one occupied by Wilson Redfearn, which was destroyed by the fire night before last, was badly damaged by the fire and was thought during the fire that this building would fall. After the fire was over Bennett Bros. moved the goods back into the building, which were removed during the fire. It was noticed during the day, yesterday that the walls seemed to be gradually giving away. The building was watched closely, and about 11 o'clock last night the wall fell and the building which was worth about \$2,000 is almost a complete wreck.

The building was owned by Messrs Burns and Mills and is supposed to be well insured. Messrs. Bennett Bro's. goods were damaged about \$1,500 by the falling wall and the rain which set in early this morning.

Wary of Life.

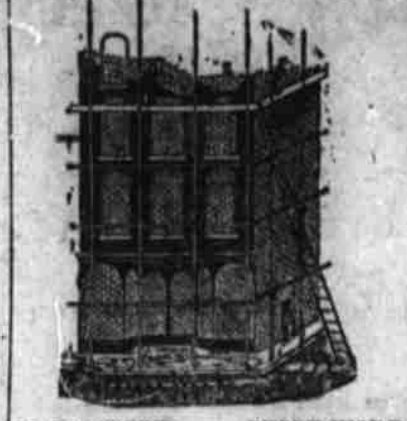

Notice is hereby given that the "Oak Hill Roller Mills" has been constituted a corporation under the provisions of Chapter 16 of the Code of North Carolina and the acts of the General Assembly amendatory thereof, and that the following is the substance of the articles of agreement filed and recorded in my office in the Records of Incorporation:

1st, The name of the corporation is: "Oak Hill Roller Mills." 2nd, Its business is to do a general milling business, to buy and sell all kinds of grain, hay and other feed, to buy and sell wood, coal and lumber, to buy, sell and work timber of all kinds, to buy and improve such real estate as may be necessary or convenient for the transaction of its business, and to dispose of the same, to issue its own notes and bonds, secured or unsecured; to take and hold the promissory notes and bonds of other corporations or individuals acquired in the transaction of its business, and endorse and dispose of the same; to acquire, hold and dispose of all kinds of personal property necessary or convenient for its business; and to do and perform all other lawful acts necessary or useful in carrying out the purposes of this incorporation.

3rd, Its principal place of business shall be at Greensboro, North Carolina. 4th, It shall continue for the term of thirty years. 5th, The following persons have subscribed to the capital stock thereof to-wit: D. F. Caldwell, L. F. Ross, T. J. Willis, J. W. Scott & Co., W. M. Houston, W. C. Bain and B. M.
