DIRECTORS' MEETING OF BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY.

At a meeting of the board of directors of the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Co., held in Atlanta, Ga., on September 1, Ben F. Geer, of Greenville, S. C., was elected a director, succeeding the late J. Epps Brown.

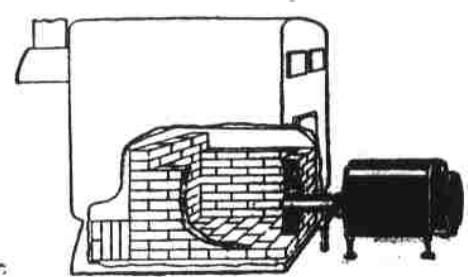
